# REDD tenure

Forest status/proponent	Tenure
State forest:	
<ul><li>Goverment</li></ul>	KPH (forest mgt unit)
Private sector	HPH, HTI, HPH-RE (concession licenses)
<ul><li>Community</li></ul>	HTR, HKm, Hutan Desa (community forestry permits)
Private forest:	
Private sector	Land title
<ul><li>Community</li></ul>	Land title

# **REDD** market

### Market:

- Compliance/regulated market – post Kyoto 20101
- Bilateral cooperation
- Voluntary market

### **Contract:**

- Market-based
- Fund based

## Working with voluntary standards

### **Suitable locations:**

#### Criteria:


- Additionality: without project the forest will be cleared/degraded
- Permanence: no/minimal conflict between emission reduction and livelihood
- Leakage: no/minimal displacement

### Comply with voluntary standards:






#### Peat in West Kalimantan


